**MTOP LEARNING OUTCOMES**

**Outcome 1: Children have a strong sense of identity**

- Children feel safe, secure and supported
- Children develop their autonomy, inter-dependence, resilience and sense of agency
- Children develop knowledgeable and confident self-identities
- Children learn to interact in relation to others with care, empathy and respect

**Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world**

- Children develop a sense of belonging to groups and communities and an understanding of the reciprocal rights and responsibilities necessary for active community participation
- Children respond to diversity with respect
- Children become aware of fairness
- Children become socially responsible and show respect for the environment

**Outcome 3: Children have a strong sense of wellbeing**

- Children become strong in their social and emotional wellbeing
- Children take increasing responsibility for their own health and physical wellbeing
